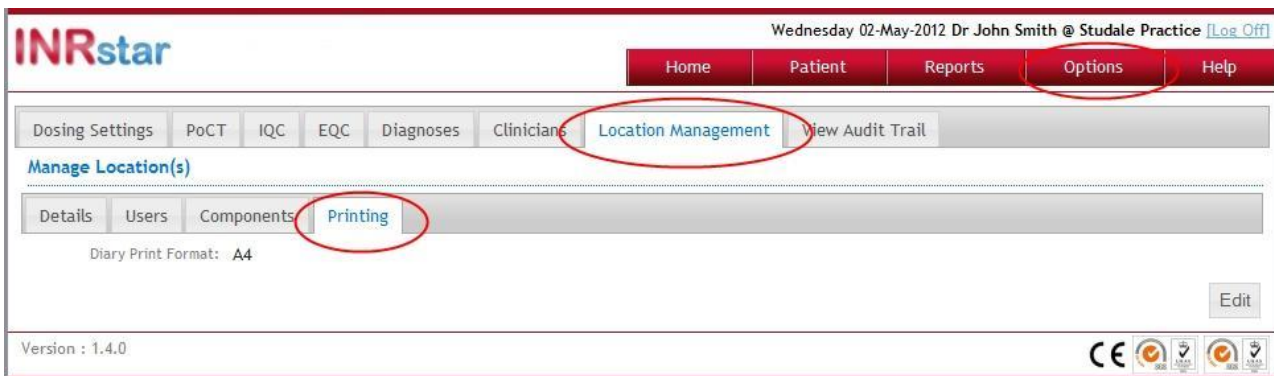

How to set up A4 Printing


Firstly, you need to set the global parameter to indicate that your location will be using A4 Printers. Then you will need to set all INRstar workstation local settings, for each user at each workstation, to point to the A4 printer attached to that workstation.

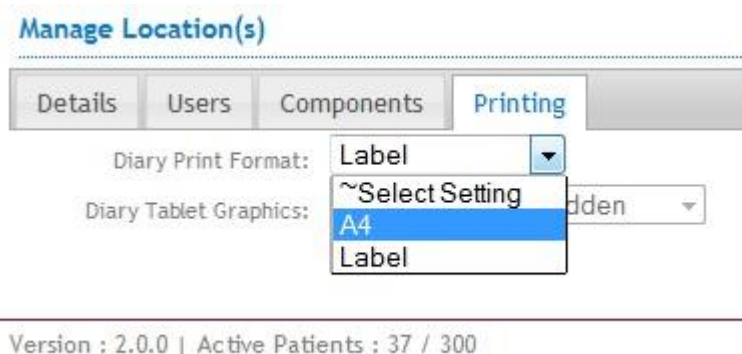
Set the global parameter

Log on to any INRstar workstation as a user with Location Administrator permissions. Navigate to Options / Location Management / Printing.

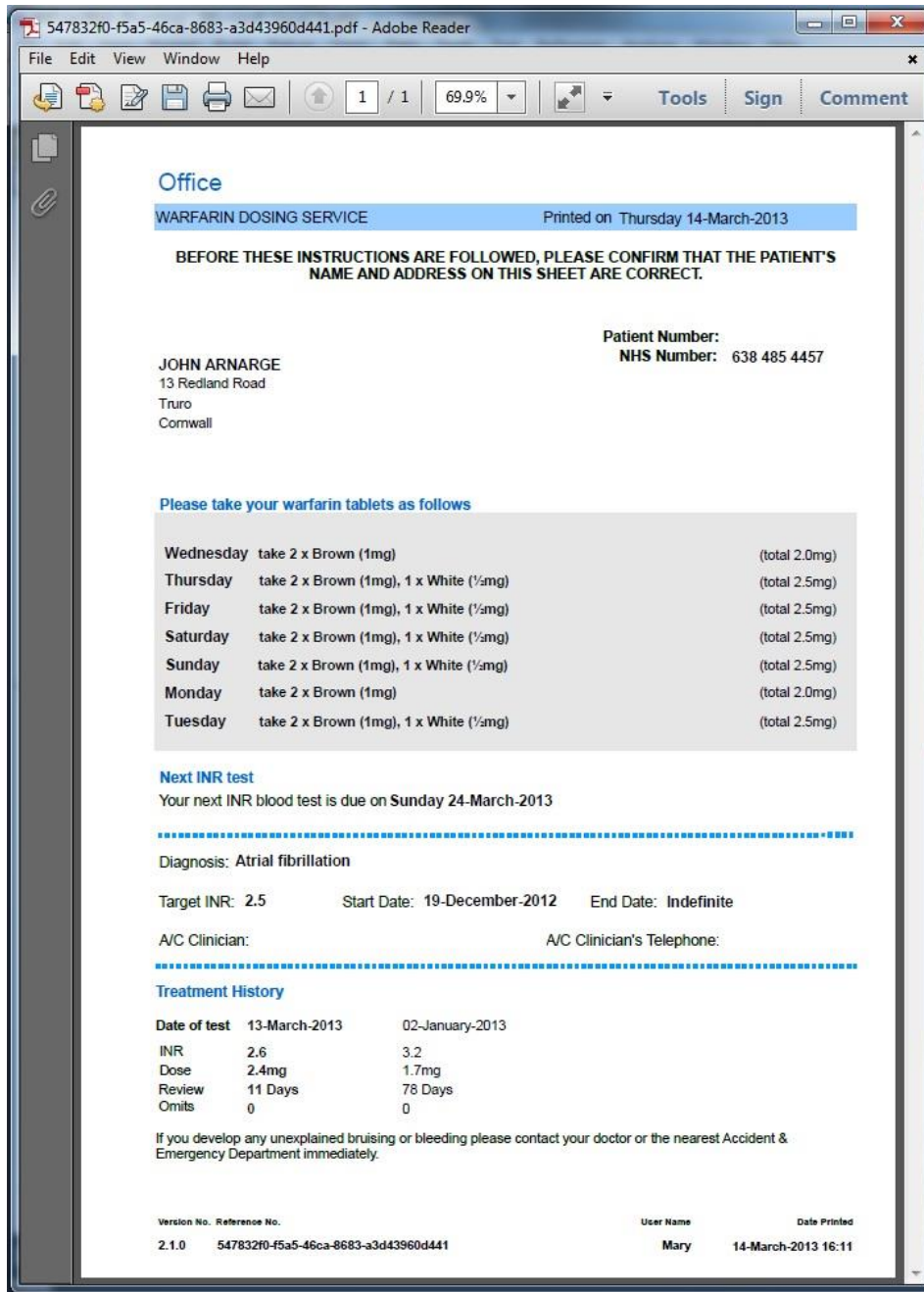

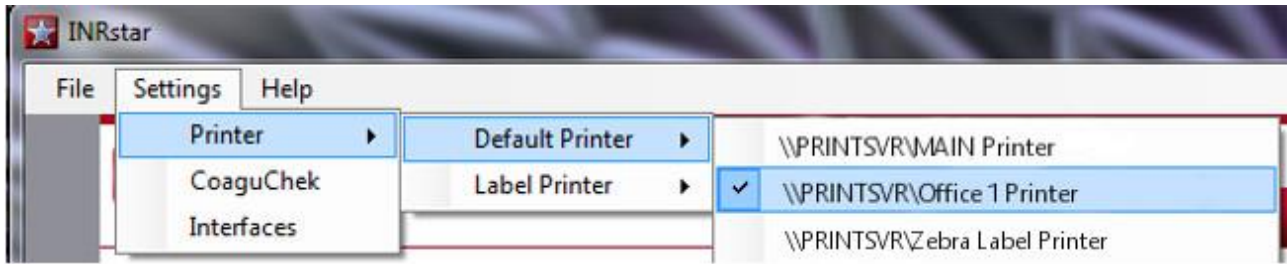

The Default printer will be used to print the practice activity, overdue and exceeded reports, overdue letters, Patient Dosing Diary and the Patient Summary document.

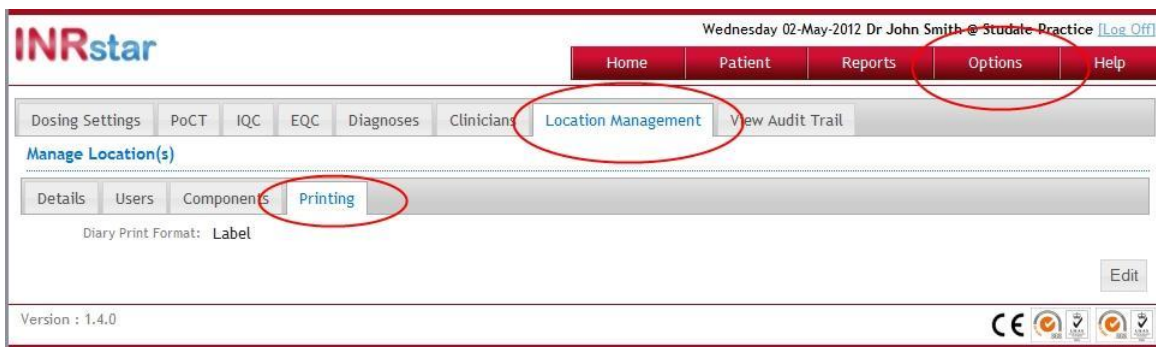
How to set up Label Printing


Firstly, you need to set the global parameter to indicate that your location will be using Label Printers. Then you will need to set all INRstar workstation local settings, for each user at each workstation, to point to the Label printer attached to that workstation. Finally you will need to set the physical printer properties to match the documents produced.

Set the global parameter

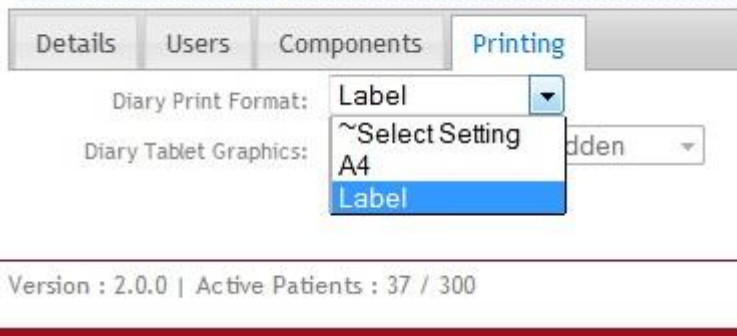
Log on to any INRstar workstation as a user with Location Administrator permissions. Navigate to Options / Location Management / Printing.

Click the  button and choose 'Label' from the selection list.

Manage Location(s)



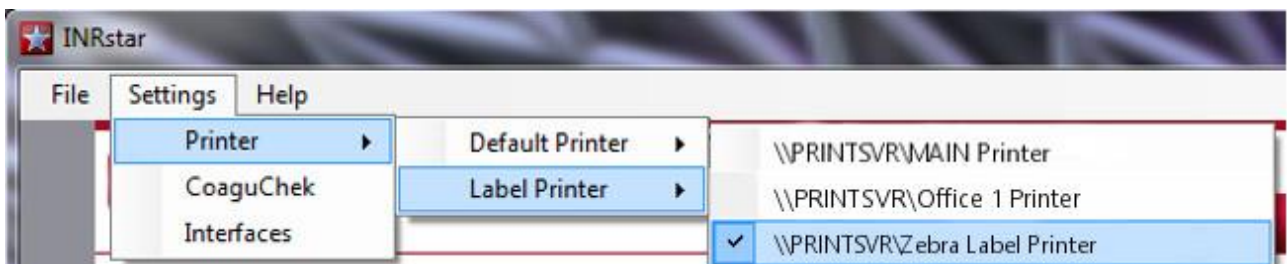
The 'Diary Tablet Graphics' selection will be set to 'Tablet Graphics Hidden', because the label dosing diary cannot display tablet graphics.

Click the  button.

Set the local workstation profiles

You will now need to set each individual INRstar workstation user's profile to point to the label printer attached to that workstation.

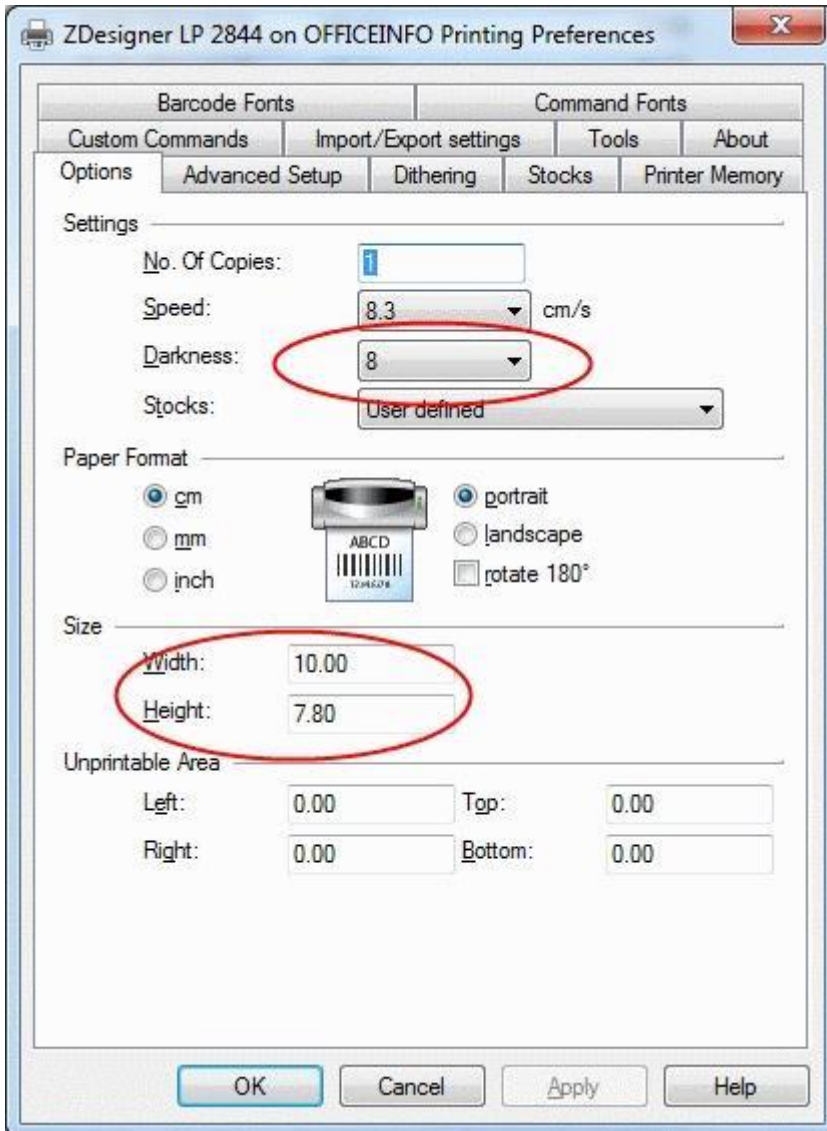
On the window in which INRstar is running, choose Settings, Printer, Label Printer and then select the appropriate printer for the workstation.



The Default printer will be used to print the practice activity, overdue and exceeded reports, overdue letters, Patient Dosing Diary and the Patient Summary document. The Label printer will only be used to print the Patient Diary and only if the global parameter has been set to 'Label'.

Setting the printer properties

This is for a Zebra LP2844 printer.

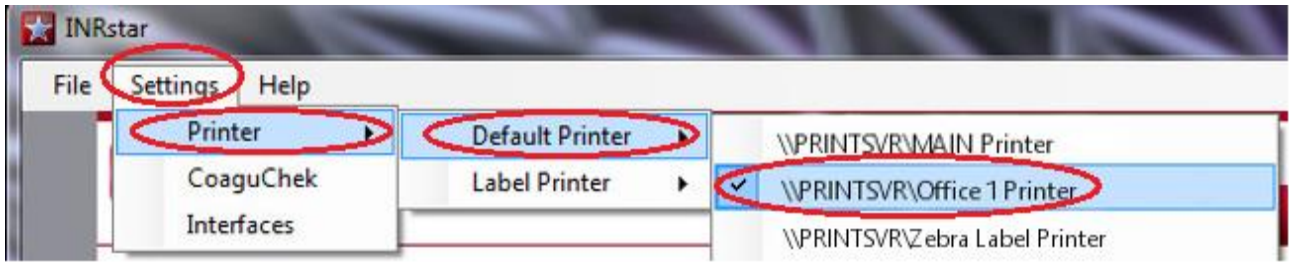


Set the size of the label to: Width : 10cm
Height : 7.8cm.
Set the Darkness to 8 or greater.
